CFAC was founded in 2019 as a result of the members' participation in Uncommon Communities, a Winthrop Rockefeller Institute program. The citizen cohort members were inspired to get involved in community development, and chose to focus on bringing more arts and art programming into the community.

- Collaboration on Placemaking Project with City of Cabot (April 2019)
- Obtain funding from Cabot A&P Commission for Placemaking (March 2019)
- Established 501(c)3 non-profit organization – CFAC (Jan 2019)
